___ **STRESS ECHO**

This test involves walking on a treadmill. Hold all medication prior to the test (if you take your BP medicine at night, hold the dose prior to the test) Do not eat/drink caffeine/smoke 2 hours prior to the test. You may have water. Wear comfortable clothes and good walking shoes. Test takes 45 minutes.

___ **ECHOCARDIOGRAM**

No preparation is required. Test takes 45 minutes.

___ **STRESS CARDIOLITE**

This test involves walking on a treadmill. The second half of the test involves an injection of a radioisotope. Hold all medications prior to the test. Do not eat/drink caffeine/smoke 4 hours prior to the test. You may have water. Wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Test takes 3-5 hours. You will have a break to get something to eat.

___ **PHARMACOLOGIC CARDIOLITE STRESS TEST**

Hold all medications prior to the test. Notify the lab if you take any Persantine, Theophylline, Dipyridamole, Hydrochlorothiazide, Diazide, Maxide, or medications for Asthma/Bronchitis. Do not eat or smoke 4 hours prior to test. You may have water. Test takes 3-5 hours. You will have a break to get something to eat.
